PRE-ORDER FORM

For pre-orders, a \$100.00 purchase minimum is required, with a 50% deposit due upon order placement. Orders must be received at the WCD office no later than Friday March 7, 2008. Pick-up for pre-orders is March 22nd, 9am-4pm.

PLACING A PRE-ORDER

There are two ways to place a pre-order. 1) Fill out Pre-Order form completely. Mail it to the WCD office with a 50% deposit (check made payable to WCD). 2) Fill out Pre-Order form completely. Bring it to the WCD office, with a 50% deposit. Payment must be made by cash or check. Pre-orders must total a minimum of \$100. Order form and 50% payment must be received in the WCD office by March 7, 2008.

PICK UP PRE-ORDERS

Saturday March 22nd between 9:00am and 4:00pm at the Community Food Co-Op's new north Bellingham store located at the corner of Cordata Parkway and Westerly Road just north of Bakerview. Stay for our Native Plant Expo to visit educational booths, talk to our knowledgeable staff about how to grow native plants, and look at native perennials available from local vendors.

A plant grown as a plug will develop a more fibrous root system than one grown in the field.</p> <p>BR = Bare root: seedling with soil removed from roots.</p> <p>1-0: 1-year-old BR plant grown 1 year in a seedling bed.</p> <p>2-0: 2-year-old BR plant grown in a seed bed.</p>	<p>2-1: 3-year-old BR plant grown 2 years in a seed bed and 1 year in a transplant bed.</p> <p>P-1: 2-year-old BR plant grown 1 year as a plug and 1 year in a transplant bed.</p> <p>P-2: 3-year-old BR plant grown 1 year as plug and 2 years in a transplant bed.</p> <p>Whip: 36" unrooted cutting</p>
